Youth Baseball Equipment Information for New Players

It is important that all players have proper equipment and look good to play baseball. Uniforms are important as they help instill a sense of team and pride for each player. For this reason, we would like players to come to practice dressed appropriately in baseball gear with the team logo though we understand that this is not always possible. In addition to the team uniform, the club sells new club Tshirts and we have a selection of used items which we urge you to consider.

The club will provide a Mets jersey top and a cap for each player but parents will need to source the other items. Regarding colours, grey trousers are preferred but white can work as well. Trousers come in basically two lengths (traditional shorter ones and longer over the ankle). This is a personal choice and one sees players wearing different kinds across the leagues including MLB. I think shorter is more traditional and preferable but then you need long socks to go with...

All boys should have some kind of personal protection for their private parts using shorts or athletic supporter. The younger they get used to this the better as many players tend to not like these. One can also find sliding shorts with a place for a cup and the upper legs and behind are a bit protected when sliding on the ground.

Regarding cleats, it is important to note that baseball cleats allow rotation of the foot when hitting and throwing, something football cleats do not. Many players in the UK use football cleats but wherever possible one should try to source baseball cleats. We realise it is not always feasible here in the UK so if you are travelling abroad it is good to consider buying them then.
